He is also still engaged in FTK**** – the Research Institute for Telecommunication in Dortmund. Now he is a member of the advisory board there. Further he is active in the working group Science and Theology, working group Bagamoyo (Tanzania) and Boende Partnership (DR Congo). And last but not least, he has a number of hobbies like wine tasting, gathering mushrooms, cooking, travelling and skiing. He also spends a lot of time with his children, grand children and in his garden.

The chats at the reunion were accompanied by wonderful classical music from the piano played by a former member of the staff (Dr. Johannes Wissing), who might just as well have studied music instead of electrical engineering!

Casually Professor Kaderali observed, that he had hoped, that the reunion with his former staff members would relieve his wine cellar, however the contrary had happened. He had received more wine as presents than had been drunk today. Further he had received delicate food and the large Johnson encyclopaedia of wine.
